Participation in at least four events or programs sponsored by educational institutions relating to career opportunities in broadcasting	During the 2022-2023 school year we utilized students from Westwood High School to operate the video camera during the Facebook live video coverage of Boys and Girls basketball games on WZAM. Each student was given a brief demonstration of how to work the camera and how to follow the action on the court. In all, 31 games were covered. There were a few students who did it multiple times and one mentioned that he might want to go into media production in college.
	Ed Janisse (General Manager of Radio Operations), was asked by Heather Grentz, the Guidance Counselor of L'Anse Junior Senior High School to make a presentation to her Career Prep Class. The career prep class is a requirement for graduation and is an opportunity for students to explore their interests and become exposed to careers that they may find interesting. On May 16 <sup>th</sup> , 2023, Ed spent time to show how he grew up in the radio industry and what skills we look for when placing employees within our organization. Topics discussed in the class was career pathways, courses of interest, employability and soft skills. It was a great opportunity and Ed has been asked to make two presentations (1 per semester) next year.
